
Expected Characteristics and Traits for Success

People employed in Cosmetology/Beauty Industry will be working in a fast-paced, constantly changing, highly technical and creative field. The program is designed to prepare the student for the State Board entrance exam and to then enter the work place. Students entering this program should possess the following traits:

- ✓ Has a good attitude and is passionate about working
- ✓ Eager and willing to learn, open-minded
- ✓ Excellent attendance (Industry standard is 95% or above)
- ✓ Is physically fit (stylists stand for up to 12 hours a day)
- ✓ Should have passed or be enrolled in Algebra 1
- ✓ Should read at a 9th grade level (large medical and technical vocabulary)
- ✓ Is able to follow specific written and verbal instructions

- ✓ Must have good communication skills
- ✓ Must have good hand/eye coordination
- ✓ Must be able to work independently and as part of a team
