RCTC

The last classes for 2003-04 will conclude at the end of the month. The only class scheduled for the summer months is the PA State Inspection class, which will be offered in July and August.

The final annual reports to PDE are being compiled and should be completed prior to the Board meeting.

The RCTC course catalog for 2004-05 will be completed by the end of June, with a few minor changes.

We are conducting a follow-up on students who collected unemployment compensation this past year, making them eligible for free tuition at RCTC. We hope to determine if the classes had a positive impact on their situation. Thus far, we have been able to contact 27 of approximately 70 receiving free tuition. The respondents expressed gratitude for the opportunity and gave high praise to the instructors. A number of them have since found employment.

New Choices / New Options

We participated in the Erie City School District's Fun Fest for their Teen Parent program on June 23, providing career information and resources to students.

Mary Ellen Camp will be attending the annual PA Career and Technical Education Conference in Seven Springs June 23 through 25.

All NC/NO classes are finished for this year and final PDE reports are being compiled. A total of seven 60-hour programs were conducted this year, serving 93 participants.

The next class will begin on September 13.
