ERIE COUNTY TECHNICAL SCHOOL WINS AMERICAN HOTEL & LODGING ASSOCIATION'S NATIONAL COMPETITION



A four-member team from the Erie County Technical School's Tourism & Hospitality Management program has won the American Hotel & Lodging Association's Inaugural Lodging Management Program Competition. The event allowed outstanding high school students to demonstrate their knowledge and skill sets needed for advancement within the U.S. lodging industry.

The winning team included seniors, **Dawn Anselment**, General McLane High School; **Katie Caldwell**, Ft. LeBoeuf High School; **Krystal Nolan**, McDowell High School; and **Lindsey Stevenson**, Harbor Creek High School. these students were awarded scholarships

of \$5,000 at Johnson & Wales, \$2,000 at San Diego State, \$1,000 at the University of Delaware and \$4,000 at the University of Houston. The students also won round-trip airfare and first class hotel accommodations to New York City for the International Hotel/Motel and Restaurant show in November.

Robert Craft, Tourism & Hospitality Management instructor commented, *"We are extremely proud of our students. They worked very hard prior to, and during the competition to earn national recognition.
