

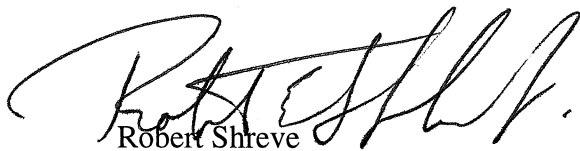

Mr. Donovan,

This is my letter of resignation. I will finish out the contract for 2003-2004 school year but will not return for 2004-2005. I have grown a lot at this job, in dealing with high school students.

I feel that the Networking Instructor position will remain as a half time position; I cannot support my family with half of a job. I addressed the board several times during the 2002-2003 school year and at the beginning of the 2003-2004 school year, with the recommendations from my advisory committee to expand the program, from a senior only to a three-year program. I stayed with the program the entire year hoping that the school would look into expanding the program. The enrollment for next year is currently at 14, which could indicate the upcoming year will be half time again. I cannot take that risk.
