DESCRIPTION:

Jesse Redfield, a junior from Girard enrolled in Computer Programming placed second at the State SkillsUSA competitions in Technical Computer Applications. The first place winner has decided not to attend the national competition in Kansas City, so this makes Jesse eligible to attend as Pennsylvania's representative. Jesse is interested in attending. His teacher, Mr. Roach Hewitt is unable to accompany Jesse to nationals. Dr. Jackson has volunteered to serve as the chaperone for the trip.

We are also recommending that another student join us on the trip as a delegate to the SkillsUSA National Leadership and Skills Conference, Sean Temple, a sophomore in Commercial Art from Ft. LeBoeuf. The conference will take place June 20 to 24, 2005. The estimated cost for the three attendees is \$2,800 (travel, lodging, registration, etc.)
