

High School Activity Report
December 14, 2004

1. The Erie County Technical School will purchase three LCD projectors at a substantial savings as a result of a grant provided by the Smarter Kids Foundation. We have ordered three NEC VT470 projectors which will greatly improve our ability to project from a computer, DVD or VCR in classrooms, labs or meeting rooms. New technology allows the VT470 to offer a bright image even in a relatively well lit space.
2. Erie County High School Counselors will hold their quarterly meeting at the Erie County Technical School on Friday, December 17th. These meetings hosted by Patty Palo and Elaine Shafer enable our sending school counselors to discuss matters related to their students' tech school issues. The attendance and productivity at these meetings is exceptional. Many logistical and communication problems are solved before they arise.
3. Mr. Donovan and Mrs. Carr, Leadership instructor, have begun planning for a student forum to discuss ECTS student views on incorporating adults into the high school programs. On December 21st, students will be given an opportunity to study and respond to the ECTS administration's plan to introduce intergenerational students to programs where it will be most beneficial.
