Term II classes were completed on December 16th; with 114 certificates of completion being awarded. In addition, 26 students completed the PA State Inspection and Mechanics Tool course classes.

Term III begins the week of January 24th. Ads were placed in the Sunday Times classified section. There are 40 classes being offered and currently 36 have at least one person enrolled. Classes with low enrollment will be canceled prior to the start date.

Two new instructors will be joining our roster in Term III.

The Corry Higher Education Council is interested in offering industrial/technical evening classes for adults at the Corry High School. They have asked for our input and assistance in getting this started. An initial meeting was held at the Corry High School on January 19.

New Choices/New Options.

At the request of PDE, we are working on gathering client data from the 2003-04 fiscal year. Although we submitted reports to PDE last year, they are now requiring that we supply data to the Department of Labor and Industry, Center for Workforce Information and Analysis.

We were scheduled to begin a program at the Union City Family Center earlier this month. It has been postponed until we can locate a child care provider for the clients in that area. We hope to have this resolved soon and begin classes before the end of the month.

We have at least four additional programs scheduled for the remainder of the school year in several locations.
