2. Several Erie County Technical School instructors will be working with Mrs. Shaffer and home school counselors this year to assist in our 9th grade recruiting efforts. This initiative gives ECTS instructors an opportunity to promote their programs and those of their colleagues with potential students from around the County. Instructors will receive training from Mrs. Shaffer and accompany her in the field to observe her presentation. Teams of two teachers will then travel to one or two sending schools.
3. ECTS Plastics Technologies students will travel to Behrend Campus to experience the traveling "Plastivan". This mobile lab will give Behrend students the chance to do some hands-on learning. Behrend staff was kind enough to offer our students an opportunity to participate as well. The time and date for this event have not been scheduled at this time.
4. On December 10, 2004, students from District 10 will visit the Erie County Technical School to compete in leadership and skill events in the annual Skills USA (formerly VICA) regional competition.
