Articulation Agreements

- Jan met with a representative of the Pittsburgh Technical Institute on December 6th to discuss development of new articulation agreements. We have proposed agreements for the following ECTS programs: Computer Information Services; Electronics; Networking Technologies; Graphic Communications; Health Assistant; and Drafting and Design. The typical articulation agreement with PTI saves our graduates approximately \$1,000.00 upon enrollment.
- Another meeting was held with a representative of Great Lakes Institute of Technology, Medical Careers Division, to discuss articulation with our Health Assistant program.
- Finally, we are working with ITT Technical Institute in Youngstown, Ohio and Bryant and Stratton (16 campuses in 4 states) to develop agreements.
- We currently have 59 articulation agreements with 31 post-secondary institutions.

National Accreditation

- Documentation has been submitted to the American Drafting and Design Association for re-certification of our Drafting and Design curriculum. We expect to receive an updated certificate in the next few weeks.

Special Education

- Approximately 88% of our students with disabilities passed the first quarter with a grade of 70 % or higher. Jan and I are meeting with the students and the instructors of those students who failed the first quarter to determine why they failed and what can be done to bring up their grade. We are currently collecting the second quarter mid-term progress reports for students with disabilities.
