1. Term V classes began May 15th and will run through June 29th. We have six classes running with a total of 52 students. This last term of the year is typically small as many courses have completed all parts and will begin anew in the fall. Our first “Blueprint Reading for Welders” class got off the ground with 6 students.
2. Another Pennsylvania Enhanced Emissions 4-hour recertification course was held May 9 and 10. We had eleven people complete this program.
3. Mary Ellen attended the Adult Coordinator’s meeting in State College on May 4 and 5. Topics included High Priority Occupations, Accreditation, Apprenticeship Training, State and Federal Legislative Activity, PDE Initiatives and Requirements related to Adult Programs, and information sharing.
4. We have scheduled an accreditation review with PDE for September 27 and 28. We will begin developing a self-study to prepare for this review. Several schools have completed this process and earned PDE accreditation while several more are in the beginning stages like us.

NEW CHOICES/NEW OPTIONS

A small class of six will complete the program on May 26th. The next program will run June 5 - 16, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

A statewide in-service is scheduled for June 1 and 2 in State College.

We are waiting for the state budget to be approved to know whether we will be funded next year.
