

High School Activity Report
October 27, 2005

1. Thanks once again to both the Millcreek and Fort Leboeuf School Districts for the provision of bus transportation for the students of the Tourism and Hospitality Program. On Tuesday and Thursday students are transported to and from the Courtyard by Marriott on Peach Street for their practical experience. This cooperation is very much appreciated.

Advanced training day provides our students with the opportunity to meet and question representatives from 30 colleges and technical schools.

The day provided a meeting in the morning, lunch, and the ability for counselors to view the labs and observe their students at the tech school.
