Software

Working with Joe Salorino, we have completed the Graphics Art Lab image. To this point we had been using a temporary base image. The new image includes updated software, additional printers and enhanced security measures.

We are in the process of finishing the Commercial Arts image. We believe this image will be deployed in the next two weeks.

Network

The IT Department has created individual user accounts in the following labs: Graphics, Commercial Art, Culinary Arts, Networking, Computer Programming, Drafting and Child Care. Using individual accounts allows the IT Department to provide users with network storage, shared class drives and the tracking of Internet activity.

Working with Phylis Zimmerman, we have added 3 additional computers to her lab configuration. The additional computers will accommodate her increasing enrollment.

Skill Center

We have finished configuring additional computers for the alternative education program. An additional 5 staff computers and 10 lab computers were added to our network.

We are also working with Kubinski Business Systems to provide the Alternative Education program with a multifunction printer/copier for the main office area. In addition to the copier we have placed an HP 4000 printer in each of the Skill Center Labs.

Maintenance

Over the course of the last month we continued to push out Windows updates. These updates included the latest service pack for Windows XP and Internet Explorer.

We are continuing to provide on-going maintenance to our servers and workstations.
