



ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Erie County Technical School

Erie County Technical School and Bryant and Stratton College enter into this Agreement on this 31st day of August 2006. Erie County Technical School and Bryant & Stratton College are committed to establishing and promoting this articulation agreement to enhance the educational services and training offered to students of the Erie County Technical School.

The goal of this Articulation Agreement is to provide students of Erie County Technical School the opportunity to earn college credit for college level learning experiences which occurred during high school. Transfer credit will be available to graduates of Erie County Technical School for courses that have been approved by the Academic Affairs Committee at Bryant & Stratton College.

We parties agree that in order for students to receive transfer credit they must:

1. Enroll at Bryant & Stratton College within one year of high school graduation.
2. Earn a grade of "B" or better in the course that they desire to articulate.
3. Successfully complete the required entrance exam at Bryant & Stratton College.
4. Successfully complete one semester at Bryant & Stratton College before the credit will appear on the college transcript.
