1. Operations & Management Review

The administration shared the results from the annual Operations & Management survey conducted with faculty and staff. Overall, all campus services received grades of “B” or better. A majority of the services also showed an improvement in scores from last year. Survey results did indicate the further study safety and security on the campus.

3. Curriculum Development Report

Fourteen instructors participated in a summer curriculum workshop held over a two week period, June 18th-29th. Instructors were able to use that information as they updated their sequence of instruction. They reviewed NOCTI competency categories and Pennsylvania Career Education and Work Standards, aligning both to our curriculum.
