Curriculum Development

Summer Curriculum Workshop- Fourteen instructors participated in a summer curriculum workshop held over a two week period, June 18th-29th. One of the objectives of the workshop was to review data of student performance on the NOCTI written tests over a three year period. Instructors were able to use that information as they updated their sequence of instruction. They reviewed NOCTI competency categories and Pennsylvania Career Education and Work Standards, aligning both to our curriculum.

Instructors met with our math teacher, Stephanie Hamilton, to plan for and schedule related math classes for the 2007-2008 school year.

Three textbook publishers (Glencoe-McGraw Hill, Thomson-Delmar and Goodheart-Wilcox) sent sales representatives to set up a book fair again this year, and our instructors were able to evaluate various options before requesting new books for their students. A motion for approval of new textbooks will be presented at the July board meeting.

Special Education

End of the Year Report Cards - Jan and Pat sent out the fourth quarter grades, for all students with Individualized Education Plans (IEPs) and Section 504 Plans, to our home schools' special education staff and guidance counselors. The percent of these students who failed was less than five percent (ten students).
