In addition there are 11 students in the PA State Inspection class for May. This is the only class that will continue to be offered in the summer months.

The GD&T class we are providing at Electric Materials Co. will conclude on May 24. Nineteen employees received this training.

Mary Ellen served on an accreditation review team for Schuylkill Technology Center in April. STC offers intergenerational training as well as full-time day and part-time adult evening classes.

**New Choices/ New Options**

Our evening program held at ECTS continues through May 31. These participants have had the advantage of working on computers each week, developing skills, searching careers, and creating resumes.

The final program for this year will be at the Bethany Outreach Center, June 18 through 29.

We have agreed to provide a series of four classes in life-skills to residents of Hope House, a transitional living center and homeless shelter for families. This will take place at their site in early August.
