ERIE COUNTY TECHNICAL SCHOOL**

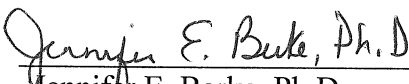
It is agreed that Mercyhurst North East College and Erie County Technical School desire to develop an academic articulation agreement to enhance transfer opportunities for students enrolled in the Early Childhood Program at Erie County Technical School.

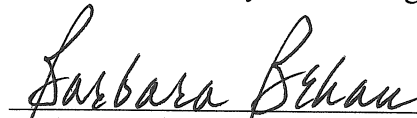
Provisions of the Academic Program Articulation Agreement:

1. A student who successfully completes the Early Child Care Program at ECTS is eligible to be awarded up to six (6) undergraduate credits from Mercyhurst North East.
2. Mercyhurst North East College will apply these credits as successful completion of its courses, *ECED 105 Health, Safety, and Nutrition* (3 credits) and *ECED 110 Family, Community, and School Partnerships* (3 credits). These credits will be applied towards the graduation requirements in the Early Childhood Associate Degree Program.
3. Evidence of successful program completion and graduation must be provided to the College in the form of a transcript, diploma, and any other official related documents. The student must meet all of the competencies required in his/her program of study.
4. These credits will be awarded upon matriculation into the Early Childhood Program at Mercyhurst North East and will meet requirements of the early childhood curriculum.

This articulation agreement will be effective immediately after representatives of both parties sign the agreement. It may be modified upon mutual agreement: it may be terminated by either institution upon a thirty-day written notice to the other party.

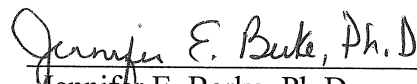

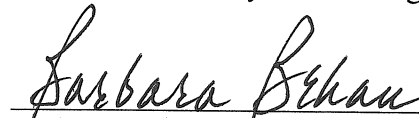
