SUBJECT: Fund-Raising Activities for SkillsUSA

DESCRIPTION:

Basket Raffle (Chinese Auction) to benefit SkillsUSA student competitors for the District competition.—Chairperson: Elaine Shaffer

Individual labs will be donating items or gift baskets for the raffle. Tickets for the Chinese Auction will be sold during lab breaks from November 28-30. Tickets will also be sold during the recruiting open house on Thursday, November 30, 2006. Money raised will be split between the labs donating the baskets to help pay for the \$20.00 registration fee per competitor for the District competition. Any additional money raised beyond the necessary \$20.00 for sponsoring a student will go directly into the SkillsUSA account.

Mini-fundraising Activities:

“Round-up” to benefit SkillsUSA. Students going to lunch on Fridays during the month of December would be asked to donate their change (round-up to the next dollar amount) from their lunch purchase to SkillsUSA.

“Hat’s On” to SkillsUSA. The lab would select a day that students would be permitted to wear hats in their lab and would donate to SkillsUSA for the privilege of wearing the hats in school. Individual labs would set their “fees”.

Carnation Sale:

SkillsUSA would like to sponsor a carnation sale with proceeds to benefit SkillsUSA. Orders for carnations would be taken during lab breaks from January 23-February 2, 2007 at a maximum cost of \$2.00 each. (cost of carnation will be determined in January 2007 based on the market value of carnations at that time)
Carnations will be delivered on February 14, 2007.
