RCTC

Most Term I classes will complete by October 19. We have printed transcripts and certificates and will be reviewing student evaluations in the next week.

Registration for our next term is currently in progress. There are 31 classes being offered for Term II, which begins October 30 and ends December 14. The two welding classes on our list were full by the second day of registration.

Our welding instructor received a request form Riley Power to refer any qualified students to the company. He referred two current students and both were hired.

Mrs. Camp also met with the Human Resource Manager from Alpha Telecom Services in New Castle regarding opportunities for welders. This information was then shared with the welding instructors and their students.

Our PA Safety Inspection program underwent an audit from the State Inspector on October 13. Everything was found to be in order.

New Choices/ New Options

The second class for the year was held at the Bethany Outreach Center from October 9 to October 20. The next session is scheduled to begin on November 6 and may be held at Mercyhurst West in Girard to better serve residents in the west county area.

Our first quarter report was sent to PDE. Twenty-seven students completed the 60-hour workshops, 10 have received additional job placement services, 17 have entered training, and two have accepted employment. In addition, 19 past completers have received short-term services so far this year.
