	112. GUIDANCE COUNSELING
1. Purpose Title 22 Sec. 4.34	A guidance counseling program is an integral part of the instructional program of the technical school. Such a program can: Assist students in achieving their optimum potential. Enable students to significantly benefit from the offerings of the technical program. Identify intellectual, emotional, social and physical needs. Aid students in recognizing options and making choices in vocational and academic educational planning. Assist students in identifying career options consistent with their abilities and goals.
2. Authority Title 22 Sec. 4.34, 12.41	The Joint Operating Committee directs that a program of guidance and counseling shall be offered to students that involves the coordinated efforts of school staff members and personnel from participating school districts, under the professional leadership of certificated guidance and counseling personnel.
3. Delegation of Responsibility Pol. 103	The Administrative Director or designee is directed to implement a guidance program that serves the needs of and is available equally to all students.
