Curriculum Development

Summer Curriculum Workshop- Fourteen instructors participated in a voluntary summer curriculum workshop held over a two week period, June 9-20, 2008 completing a variety of projects. Several instructors worked on their annual reports to maintain national accreditation. This project was paid for by our Committed to Excellence curriculum grant.
