Term IV This term runs from March 17 to May 5. There are 152 students enrolled and 22 classes offered. This is similar to last year at this time, (149 students and 23 classes). Fourteen additional classes had at least one student but not enough to run the class and were therefore canceled.

CareerLink We have received approval from the Regional Center for Workforce Excellence on four of our adult programs: Automotive Mechanic; Heating, Ventilation, and Air-Conditioning; Welding; and Medical Administrative Assistant. We are now an “approved training provider” for programs such as Dislocated Worker, TAA, Adult, and the new Career Advancement Account.

New Choices/ New Options

Classes Ten participants graduated for the program, held at the CareerLink, on March 20. Three are currently enrolled in our Term IV classes and three have been hired to begin full time employment. We continue to work with all participants until they reach their employment and training goals.

Our next class will start on April 14 at Mercyhurst West in Girard.

Leadership Day Plans are underway for our annual trip to Harrisburg for Leadership Day – a day of legislative action and solidarity – organized by Pennsylvania Women Work. This will take place on Tuesday, May 6.
