Intermediate Unit Report- NONE

Math Levels at ECTS- Jan Kennerknecht reviewed information regarding a handout created to reflect Math Standards lined up to the various labs offered at ECTS. This will help guidance counselors when choosing appropriate labs for students.

Science, Technology, Engineering & Math – (STEM) a handout advertising the STEM Governor's Institute in July was included in the handouts. Schools were encouraged to send teams for training and information.
