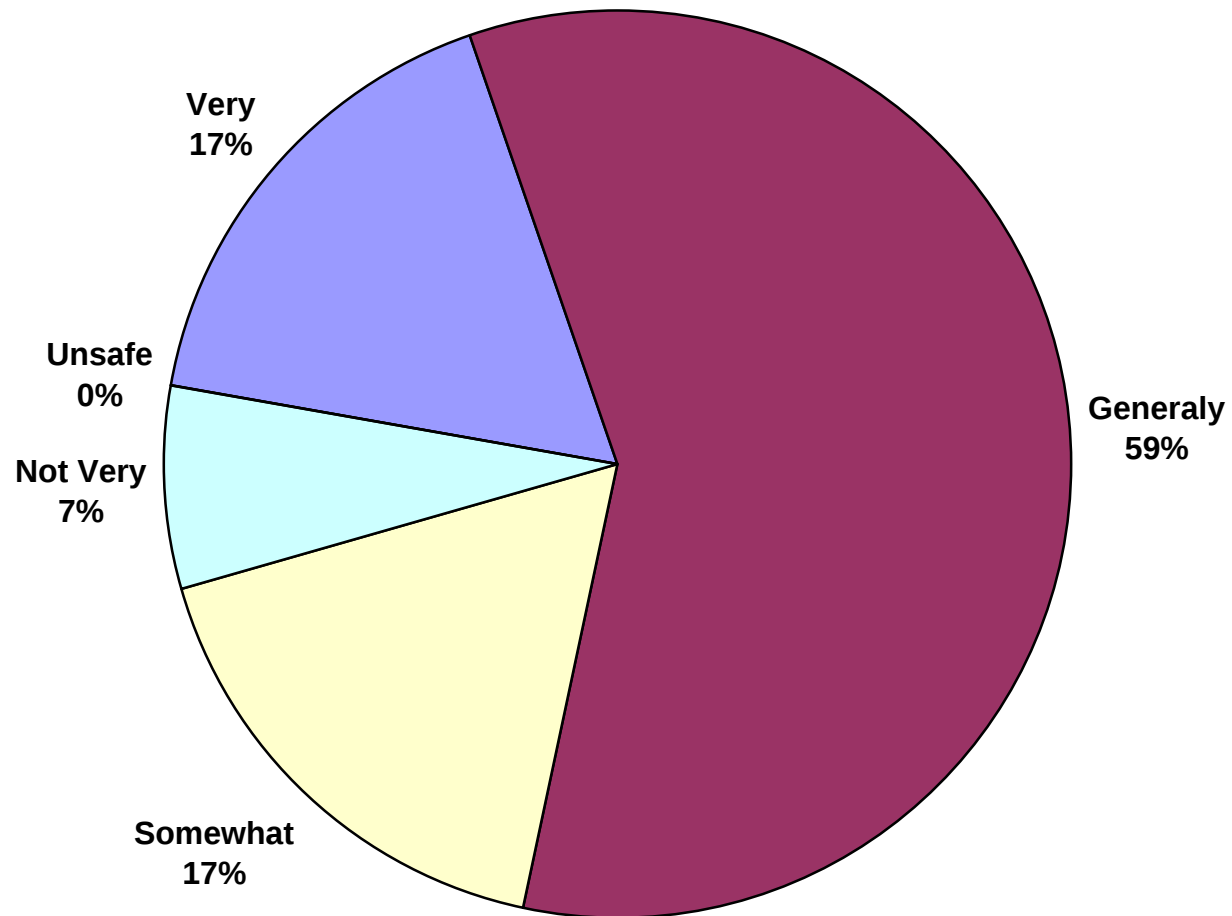


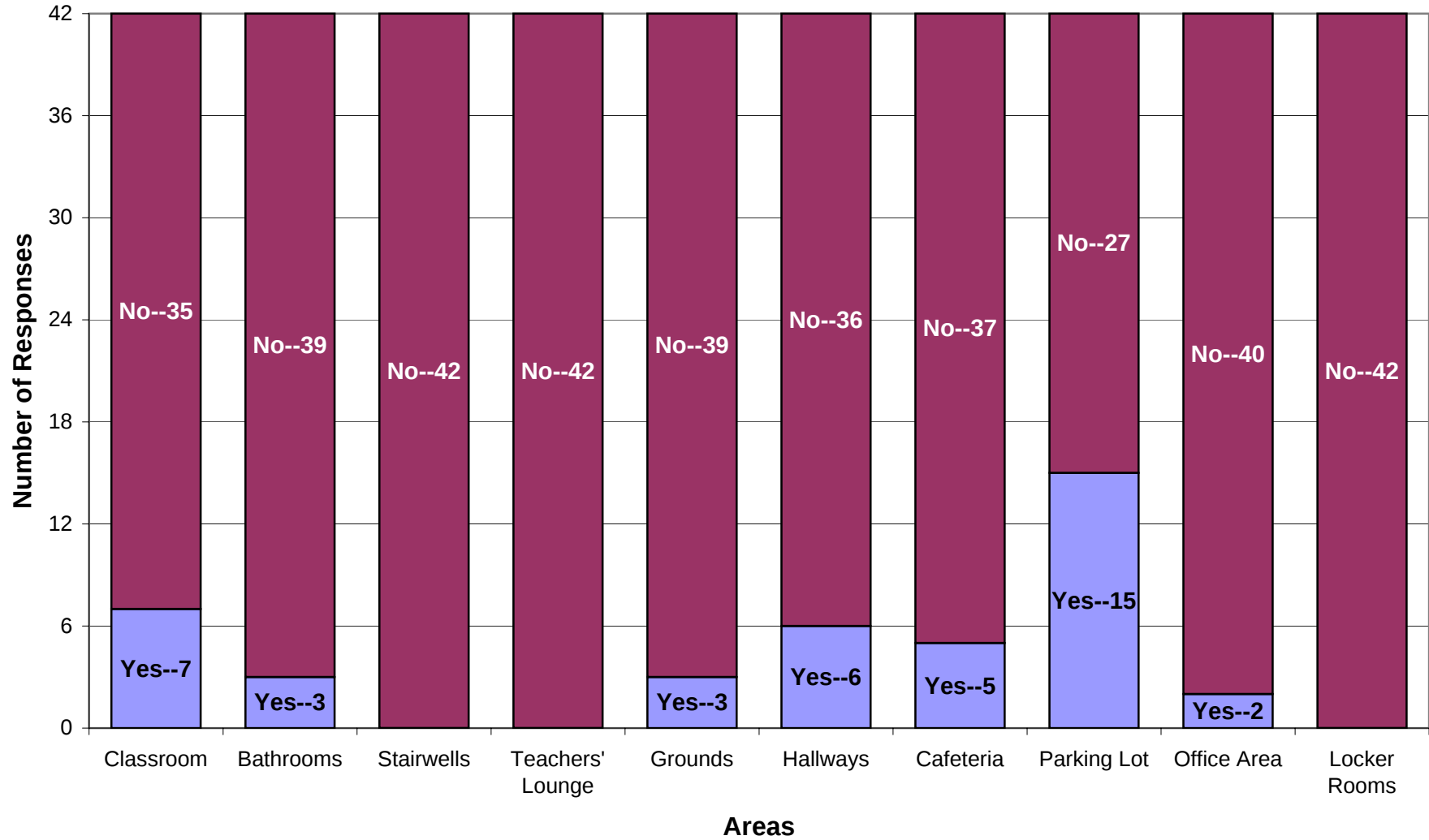

"In general, how safe do you feel at this school?"



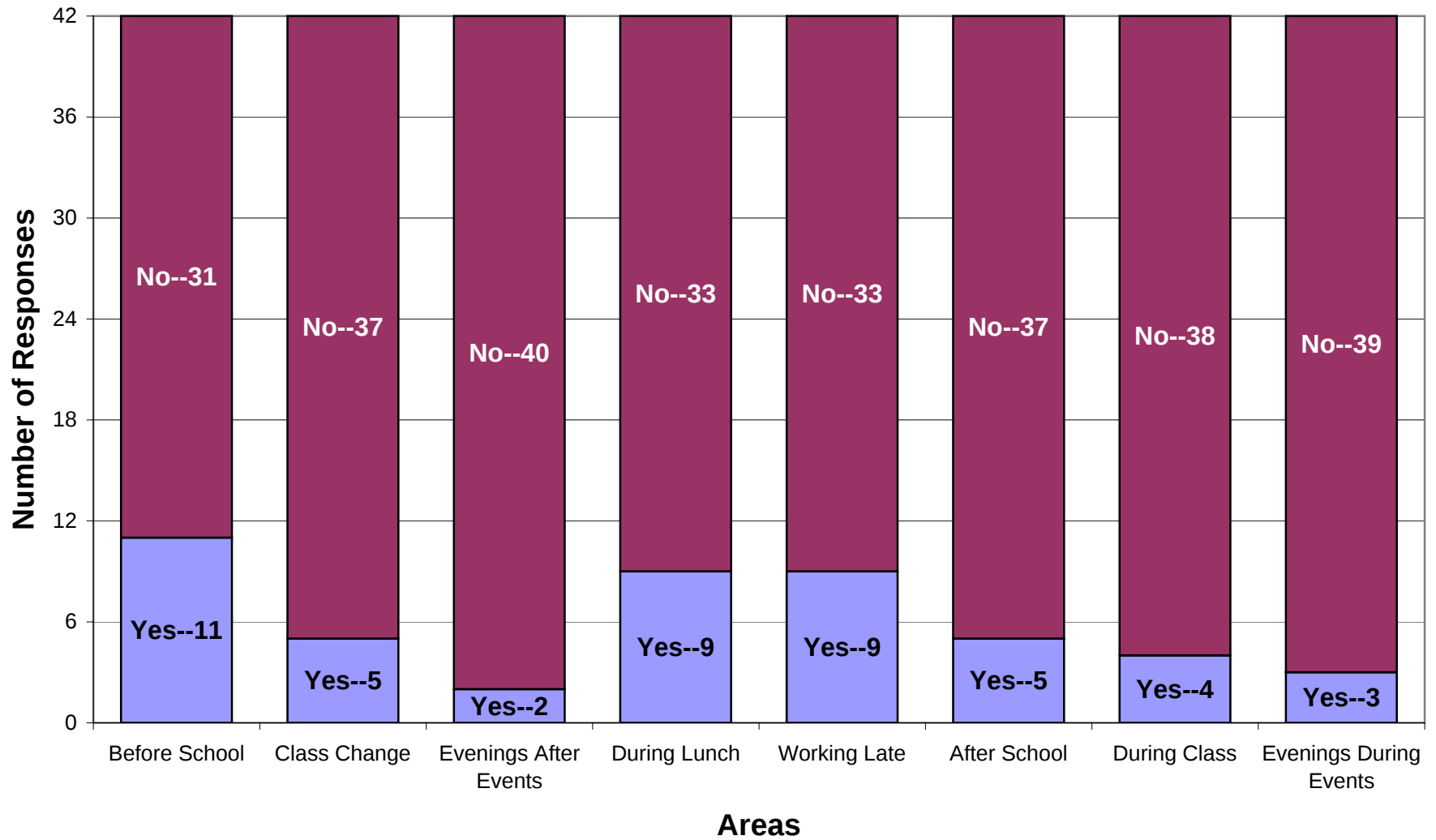

"Please indicate areas where you feel less than generally safe"



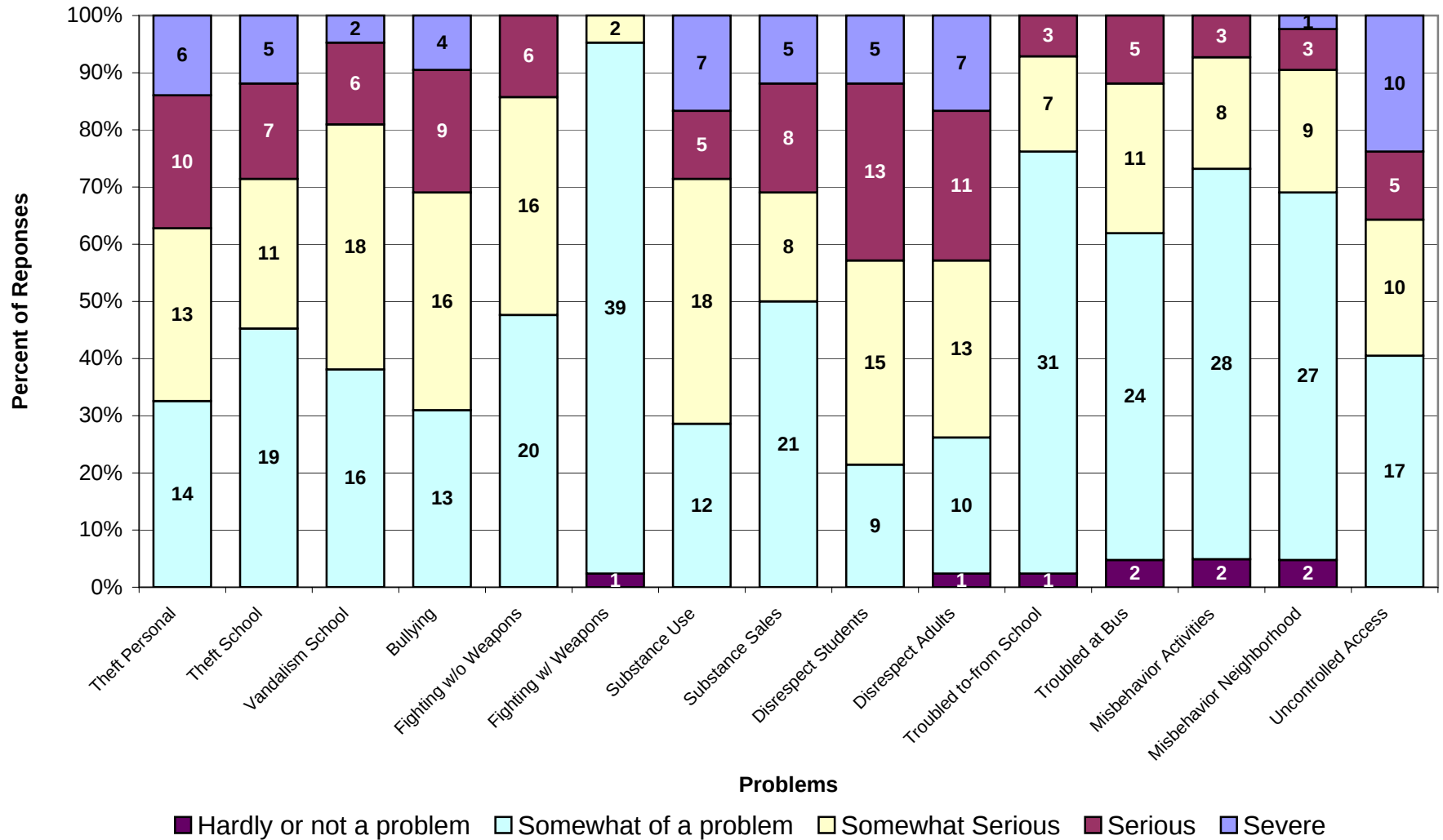
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"Please indicate the time(s) of day when you feel 'less than generally safe'"



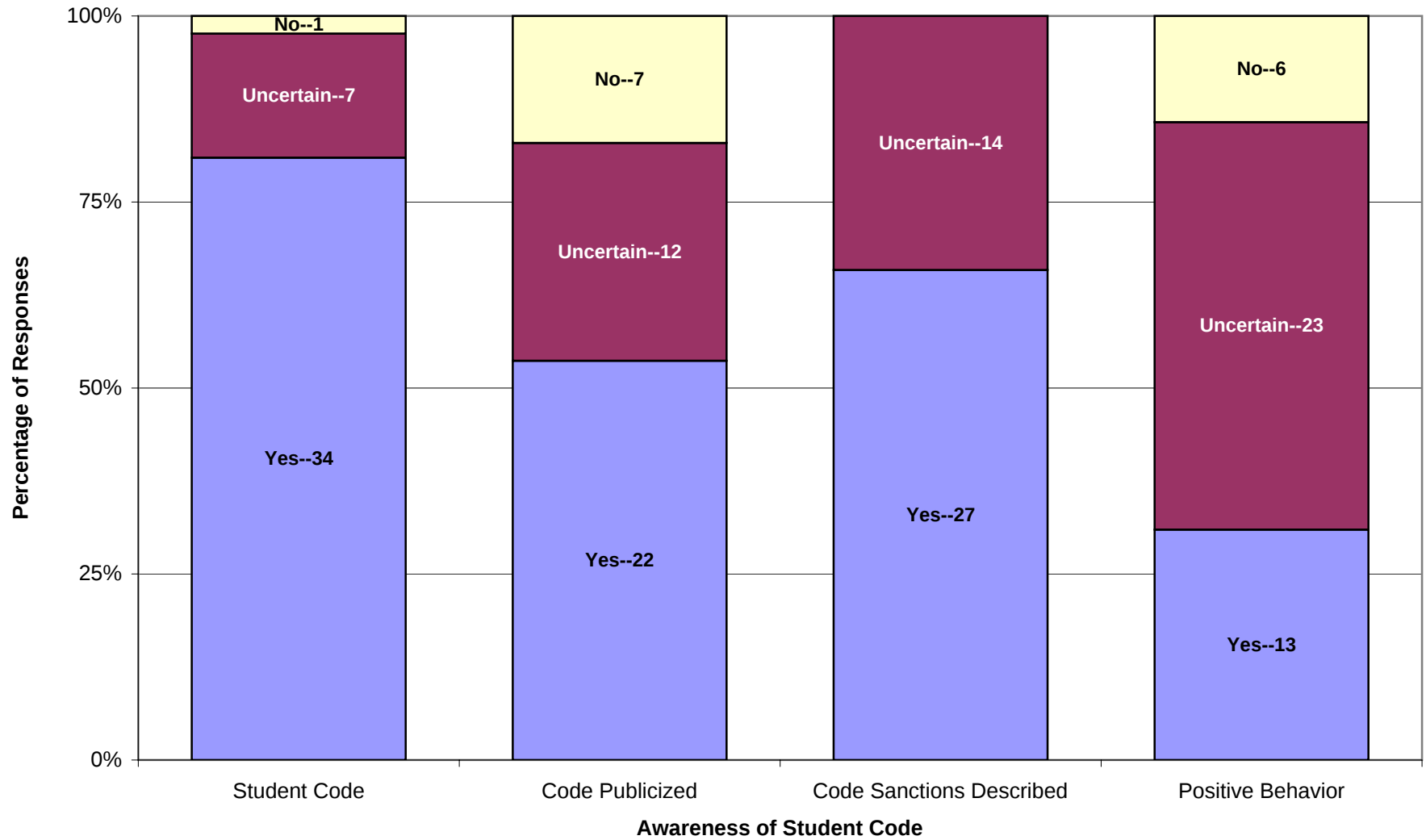

"Please indicate how much of a problem you think each of the following has been during the most recent school year"



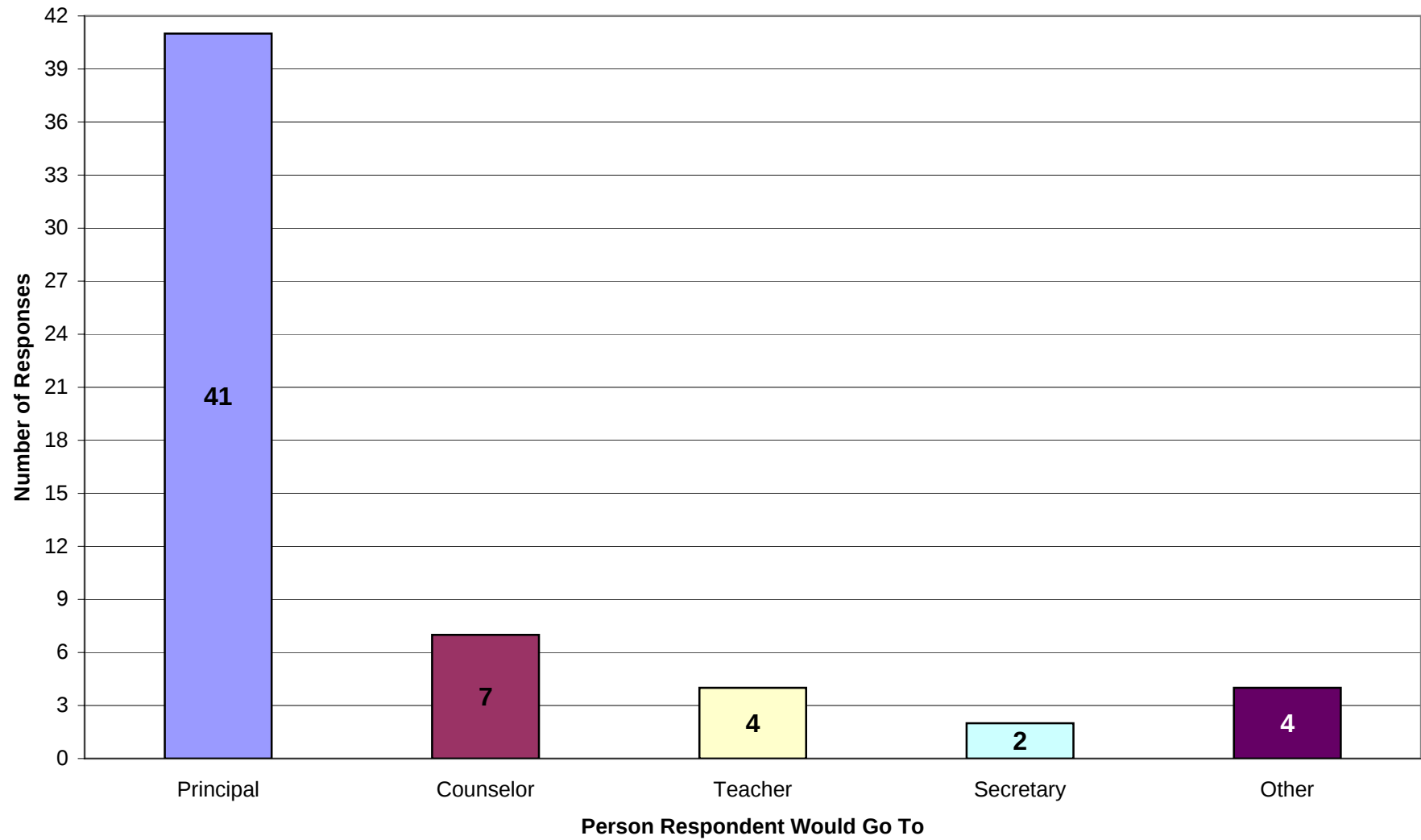

Awareness of Student Code and Positive Student Behavior



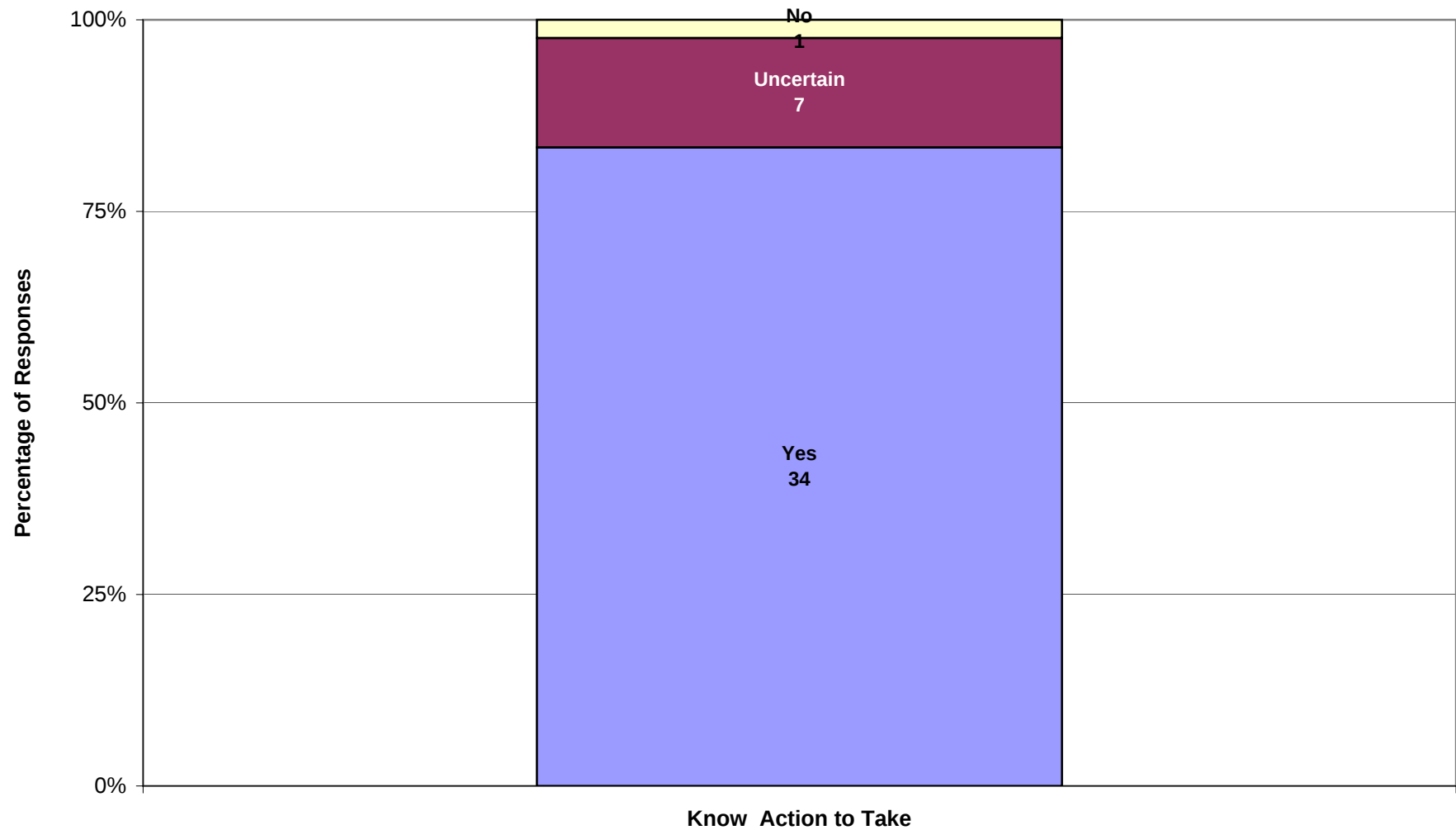
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"Who would you go to if you knew about a threat of violence at school?"



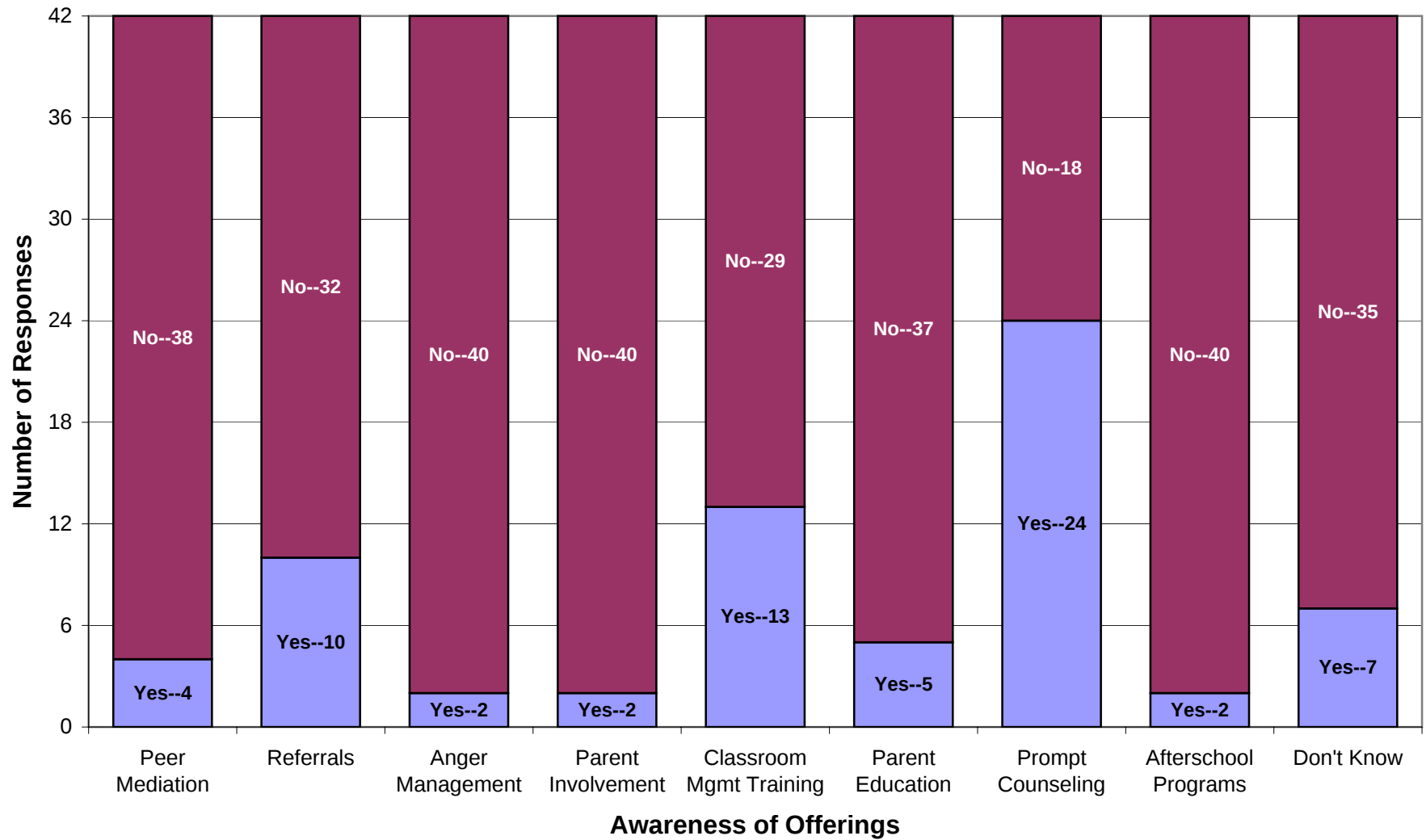
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"If a student were to report a problem or concern to you involving his or her or another student's personal safety, would you know what action to take and how to take it?"

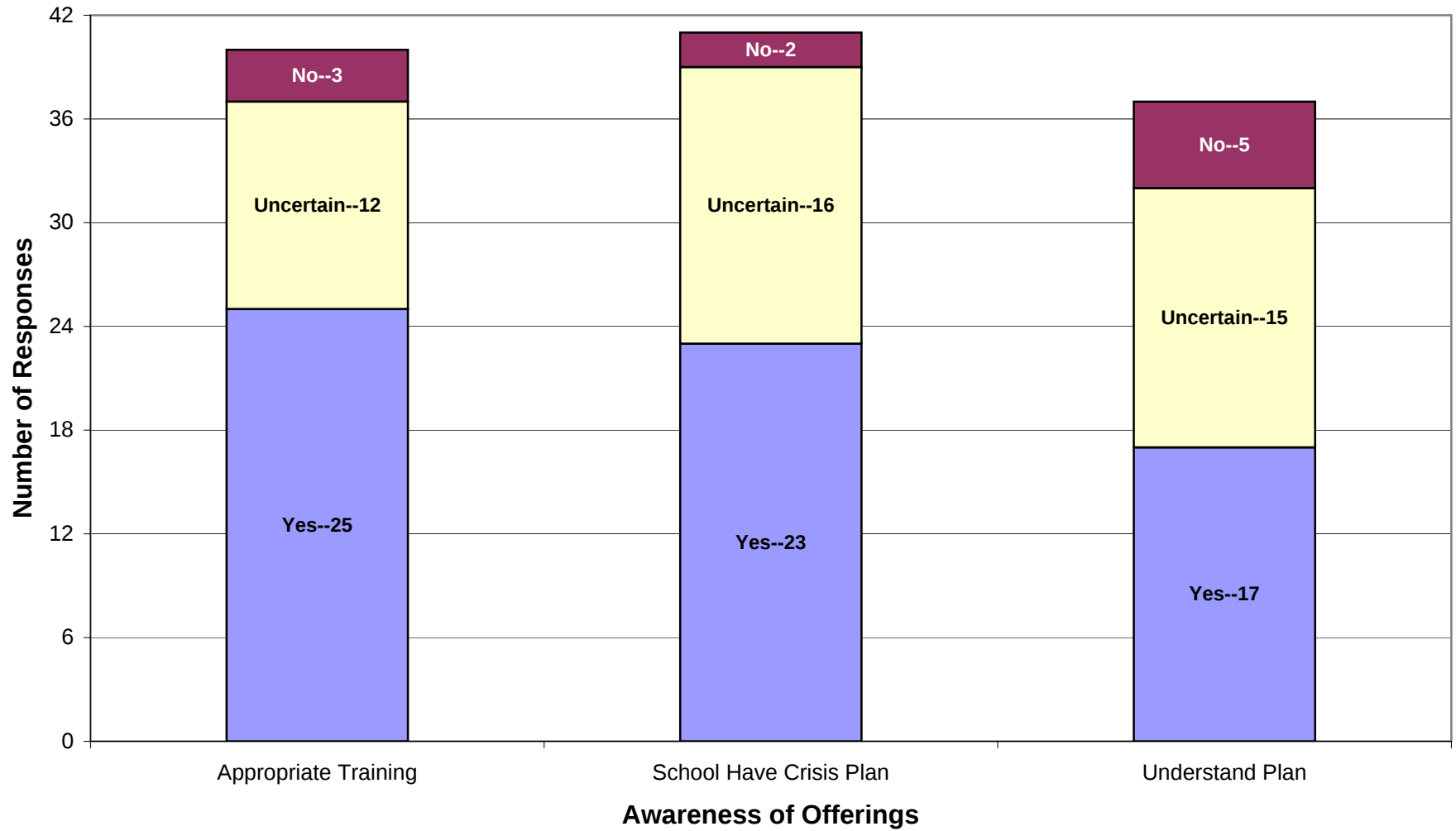

Do you feel you have current training in maintaining a safe, orderly learning environment?

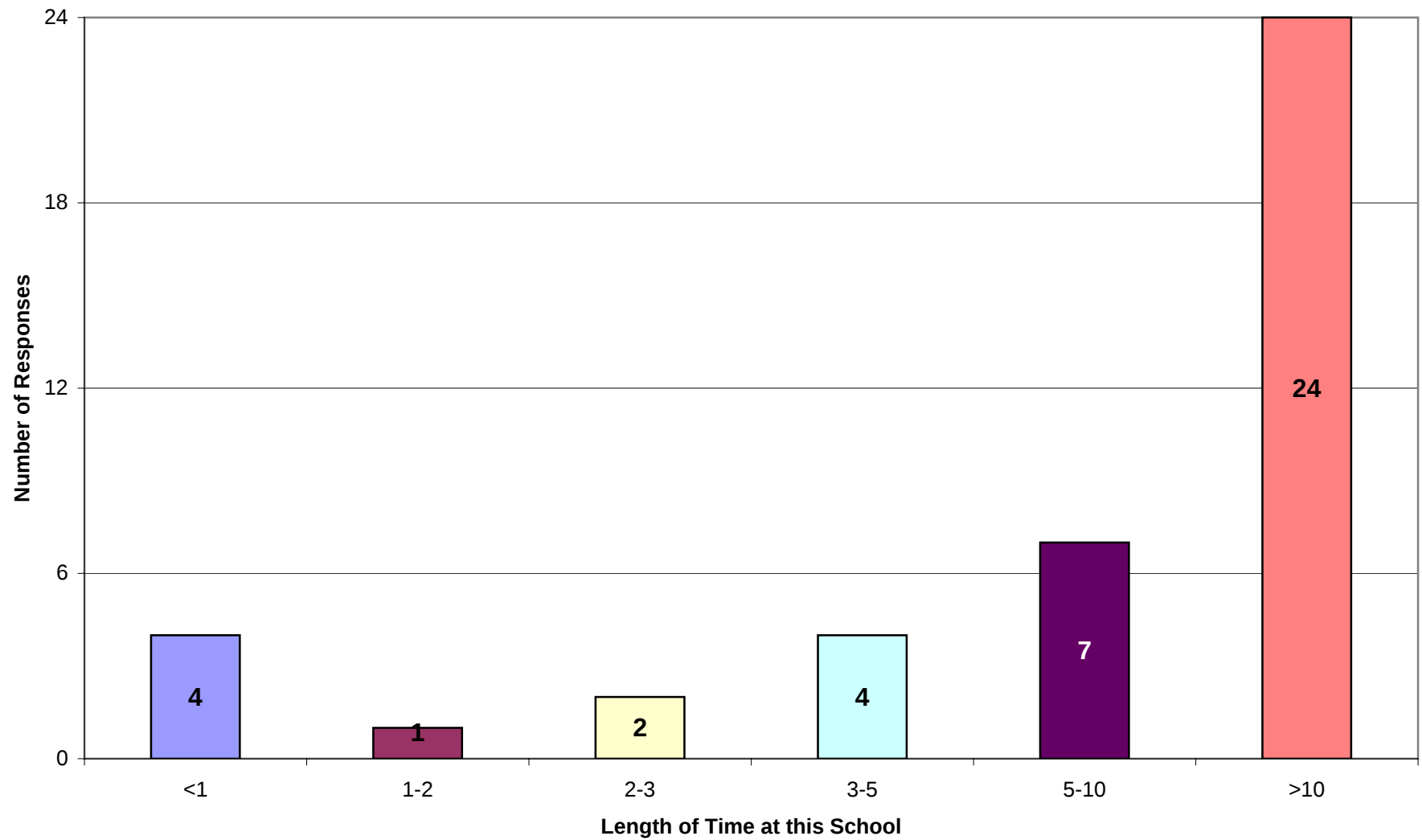

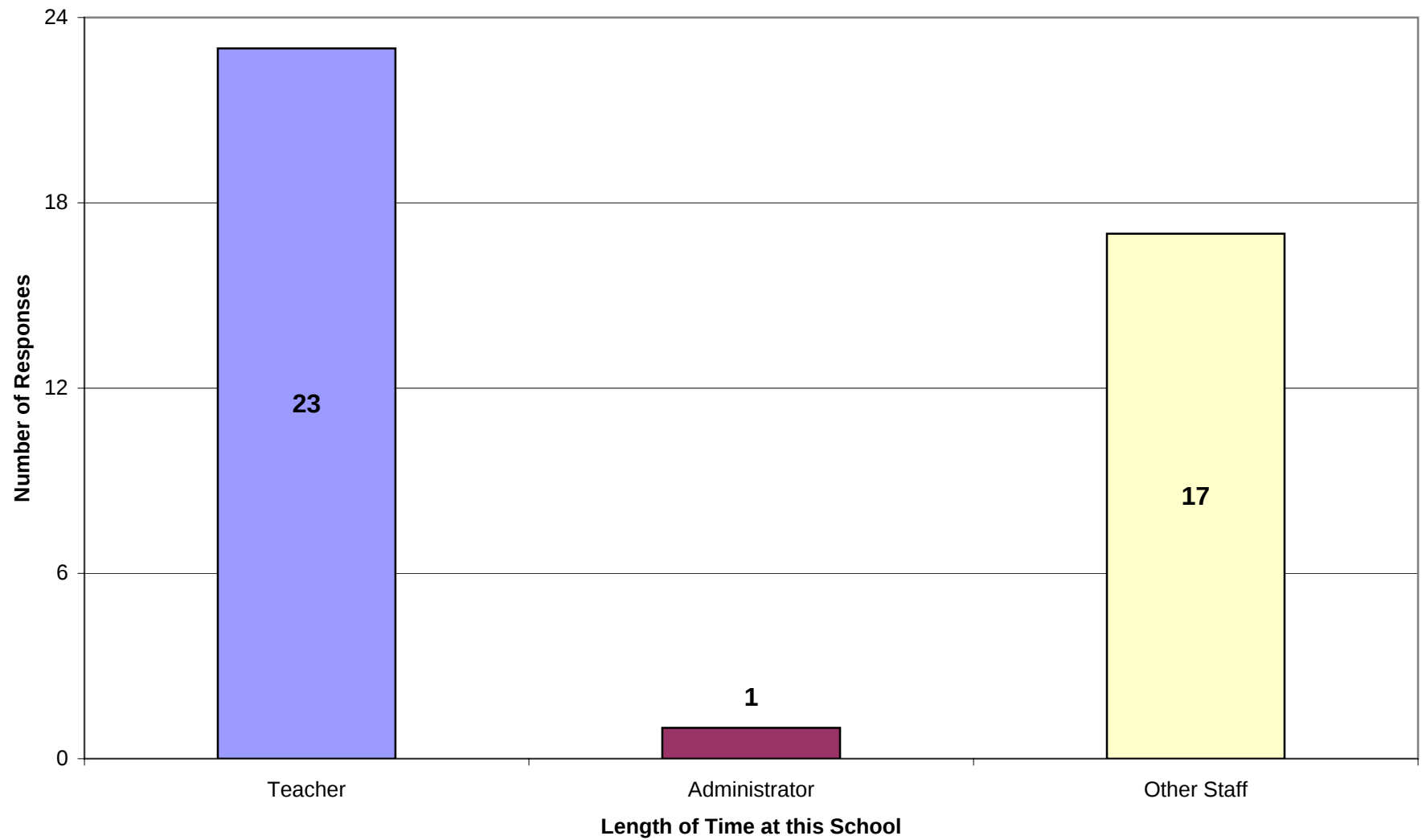

1. Individuals who are not students allowed to enter/exit building during school hours
