



**Joint Operating Committee Meeting
April 2009
School District Report**

1. Funding Formula Review

The subcommittee of superintendents charged with reviewing the funding formula met for the second time on April 15. The committee reviewed several funding models including scenarios without Millcreek as a member. There was also discussion about the quota system (or the number of seats allocated to each district) and how a funding formula change should influence that system. The committee will make a recommendation to the Professional Advisory Council on May 1. If all superintendents concur with the recommendation, they will present it to the Joint Operating Committee.

2. Transition Center

The operating committee approved two job descriptions to staff the transition center. The job descriptions were for a special education teacher and a paraprofessional.

3. Community College

Judith Fagin, project manager for REthink Erie, made a presentation to the committee regarding the results of the community survey on the need for a community college. The Clements Group of Salt Lake City, Utah conducted the survey. The final report for the survey encourages the county to pursue the development of a community college.
