Regular classes end for the summer on June 25. However, the PA State Inspection classes will be held monthly provided there are enough students; July will be an afternoon class and August will return to the evening schedule. There will be no evening hours in July.

The course offerings for 2009-10 will be available on our web site by early July. Mailers will also be sent to area business and industry in August.

New Choices/ New Options

Ninety-one people completed the required 60+ hours in the New Choices program this year. As of June 1, 36 are employed and 38 are enrolled in further education and/or training. The average starting wage for those employed is \$10.14 an hour. New Choices served an additional 27 individuals with 10 to 25 hours of service each.

The grant for funding in 2009-10 is due on June 26 to the Department of Labor & Industry. As always, grant approval is contingent on the availability of state funds.
