Curriculum Development

Summer Curriculum Workshop- Thirteen instructors participated in a summer curriculum workshop held June 15th-19th. One of the objectives of the workshop was to align their curriculum to their new PDE Program of Study. Instructors were paid through a Tech Prep grant from the Intermediate Unit.

Three textbook publishers (Glencoe-McGraw Hill, Thomson-Delmar and Goodheart-Wilcox) sent sales representatives to set up a book fair again this year, and our instructors were able to evaluate various options before requesting new books for their students. A motion for approval of new textbooks will be presented at this board meeting.

Special Education

End of the Year Grades - Jan and Pat sent out the fourth quarter grades, for all students with Individualized Education Plans (IEPs) and Section 504 Plans, to our home schools' special education staff and guidance counselors. The percent of these students who passed the year was 94%.
