This event will be open only to current ECTS students in grades 10 – 12.

Students will not be allowed to leave once they have been dropped off.

The students involved in this event will provide their own transportation to and from the event. It is preferred that the students be transported and picked up by their parents. However, should any student have to drive to this event, their keys will be collected and not available to them until the conclusion of the event at 7:00 AM.

A parental permission slip must be provided prior to the purchase of any ticket. Once the permission slip is returned along with \$5.00, parents will be provided with a telephone number to use in case of emergencies.

All tickets will cost \$5.00 and can be purchased through Mrs. Carr.

Tickets sales will end on Friday, May 7, 2010. There will be no tickets sold at the door. There will be copies of emergency forms for all students in attendance.

Supervision will be provided by ECTS faculty and staff. There will be a minimum of five ECTS staff members at all times during this event.

There will be both scheduled activities as well as "free time" planned throughout the event.

Students will be supervised at all times during the period of time that they access to the gyms, pool, and game rooms.

The pool will be guarded by a YMCA lifeguard during the hours of 11:00 to 11:00 only. The pool will be closed otherwise. To use the pool a proper and appropriate swimsuit must be worn.

All gym equipment will be provided by the YMCA.

No "heelys", wheeled shoes, or skateboards are permitted. Proper gym shoes are required.
