201. ADMISSION OF STUDENTS

1. Purpose

The Operating Committee recognizes the importance of vocational and technical education within the over-all educational system. The Operating Committee believes that a vocational or technical experience enhances a student's educational program and must be available to all students who can benefit from such an experience.

2. Authority

Selection of pupils shall be a cooperative effort by the administrator and guidance services of the participating school districts and the administrator and guidance services of the technical school provided that the final decision as to assignment to the technical school shall rest with the district of residence of the pupil; and final decision as to retention of a pupil in the technical school after one (1) semester shall rest with the authorities of the technical school.
