	201. ADMISSION OF STUDENTS
1. Purpose	The Operating Committee recognizes the importance of vocational and technical education within the over-all education system. The Operating Committee believes that a vocational or technical experience enhances a student's educational program and must be available to all students who can benefit from such an experience.
2. Authority	Selection of pupils shall be a cooperative effort by the administrator and guidance services of the participating school districts and the administrator and guidance services of the technical school provided that the final decision as to assignment to the technical school shall rest with the district of residence of the pupil; and final decision as to retention of a pupil in the technical school after one (1) semester shall rest with the authorities of the technical school.

3. Guidelines	<u>In order to qualify as a pupil at the technical school:</u> • <u>the student must be enrolled on a full-time basis at a participating school district; or</u> • <u>be a student who is a special education student with an individualized education plan requiring attendance at the technical school; or</u> • <u>be a student whose attendance at the technical school is fully subsidized by aid from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.</u>
