2ND QUARTER ECTS HONORS:

The second quarter grading period ended January 22, 2010 and with that conclusion, ECTS recognized three groups of outstanding students:

Honor Roll Student – A student who achieved a 95% or better for a lab grade.

81 students obtained the HONOR ROLL status which represents 11% of our population.

Perfect Attendance -- 136 students had PERFECT ATTENDANCE in the 2nd quarter which represents 19% of the ECTS population.

Distinguished Student – An Honor Roll student with Perfect Attendance.

28 ECTS students achieved this recognition which accounts for 4% of the ECTS population.

SKILLS USA COMPETITION RESULTS:

The Skills USA Regional competitions were held at four different venues this year. ECTS hosted the "Construction Trades" portion of the challenges while Crawford County Tech, Erie Central Tech, and Lenape hosted the remaining contests.

ECTS had six regional Gold Medal winners that will attend the "State" Skills USA competition that will be held in Hershey, PA in April.
