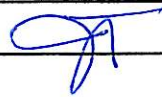

Pennsylvania School Counselors Association has enhanced their membership services statewide. Criteria:

- 1.PINS will be a point of contact for members
- 2.PINS are required to present or provide a presentation for PSCA annual conference (Conference 2011 is February 23-26 in Lancaster. before the PSSA window) PINS who present at the conference will have the conference registration fee waived (You would have to attend the conference.)
- 3.PINS will provide current and update resources for the PSCA Website
- 4.PINS are required to write 3 articles on current topics for PSCA newsletters
- 5.PINS are required to attend the PIN session meeting at the annual PSCA Leadership Academy (this year August 2010 in Erie at Gannon)
- 6.PINS will include all of the above in their annual workplan plus personal goals
- 7.PINS will report regularly with the Advisory Chair, types of meetings, dates and times to be determined by group
