DESCRIPTION:

Mr. Glen Renaud, Chief Executive Officer of The Family First Academy, made a request recently to lease four to five classrooms at the Skill Center for an international post-high school program to be held during the 2011-2012 academic year.

A review of current and projected Regional Choice Initiative enrollments and room usage by the Career Alternative Education program suggests there would not be enough space available to fulfill the request. An agreement with Family First Academy at this time for the 2011-2012 academic year would prohibit RCI and CAEP from using these classrooms.

I met with the superintendents and RCI coordinator (Dean Maynard) this morning to discuss classroom availability at the Skill Center for 2010-2011. The RCI currently uses all classrooms at the Skill Center on Tuesday and Thursday mornings and one-half of the classrooms on Monday and Wednesday mornings. RCI is projecting the enrollments will grow for 2010-2011 using even more classrooms on Monday and Wednesday mornings. Our alternative education program uses all classrooms all five afternoons.

Given the RCI projected enrollments and your need for four classrooms five mornings a week, we will not be able to accommodate your request. Thanks for considering the technical school to assist with your needs.
