Term IV classes begin the week of March 22nd. Eighteen classes are scheduled with 118 students. In addition, twenty-three students completed recertification classes for Enhanced Emissions; ten students completed the State Inspection class in March; and 29 people have taken the emissions test in our office so far this month.

We completed customized welding training for 12 members from the Greater PA Regional Council of Carpenter's on March 6.

A proposal was submitted March 15th to Strategy Solutions that will provide consortium training to several trades groups that need some type of welding training.

New Choices/ New Options

Seventeen participants completed the New Choices class held at the Adult Learning Center in Erie. Follow-up meetings are being scheduled to complete resumes, go over career plans, and provide additional assistance as needed.

The next scheduled program is set for Corry, April 12 through 30. However, if enrollment is low, we will cancel and reschedule another Erie class during this time.
