Term V classes are in session through the end of June. There are seven classes altogether, not counting the monthly PA State Inspection offering.

We are also operating three weld training classes for the Great Lakes Building and Construction Trades Industry Partnership (GLBCT). The first group began April 12 and will conclude May 26; the second group began April 20 and will conclude June 3; and the third group began May 10 and will end on June 24. There are 12 students in each group.

We will conduct the first “physical assessment” for applicants of the weatherization program on May 20. Thank you to Steve Sceiford and the Building Trades lab for putting together the different components of the assessment.

We have 9 New Choices grads enrolled in one or more RCTC classes in Term V. All have expressed appreciation for this opportunity.

There was not sufficient enrollment to hold the evening New Choices class scheduled for May. For the remainder of this school year, Mary Ellen will meet individually with those who need career guidance, assessment, information & referrals, or job readiness skills.
