SkillsUSA-Spirit Week

The ECTS chapter of SkillsUSA would like to hold a spirit week the week of May 2, 2011. The purpose is to promote school spirit and community service. Each day during the week, we would ask labs to participate in a themed attire day as outlined below. In addition, we would conduct a food drive for the Second Harvest Food Bank. On Friday, May 6, the Community Blood Bank will be here for the Blood Drive. The carnation sale will also take place on Thursday, May 5 and Friday, May 6 to support SkillsUSA.

Food Drive

Points System: Small cans of food – 1 point each, dry pasta – 2 points, hygiene items – 3 points, money – 4 points for each dollar, boxes of cereal – 5 points each.

Collection Bonus Days:

Monday – Double points for cans

Tuesday – Double points for dry pasta

Wednesday – Double points for hygiene items

Thursday – Double points for money

Friday – Double points for boxes of cereal

Point totals will be accumulated throughout the week. Total points will then be divided by the number of students in that session. The top point leaders from AM and PM will receive Popsicles (donated by Mrs. Carr.)

Spirit Themes are as follows:

Monday May 2 – Lab Color Day – Choose a color for your lab to wear and encourage all students to dress in that color.

Tuesday May 3 – High School or college pride day – Wear your high school clothing or clothing representing your favorite college

Wednesday May 4 – 80's Day – Wear clothing from the 80's era (please do not wear anything that would be a safety hazard in your occupational area.)
