New Choices Career Development/WANTO

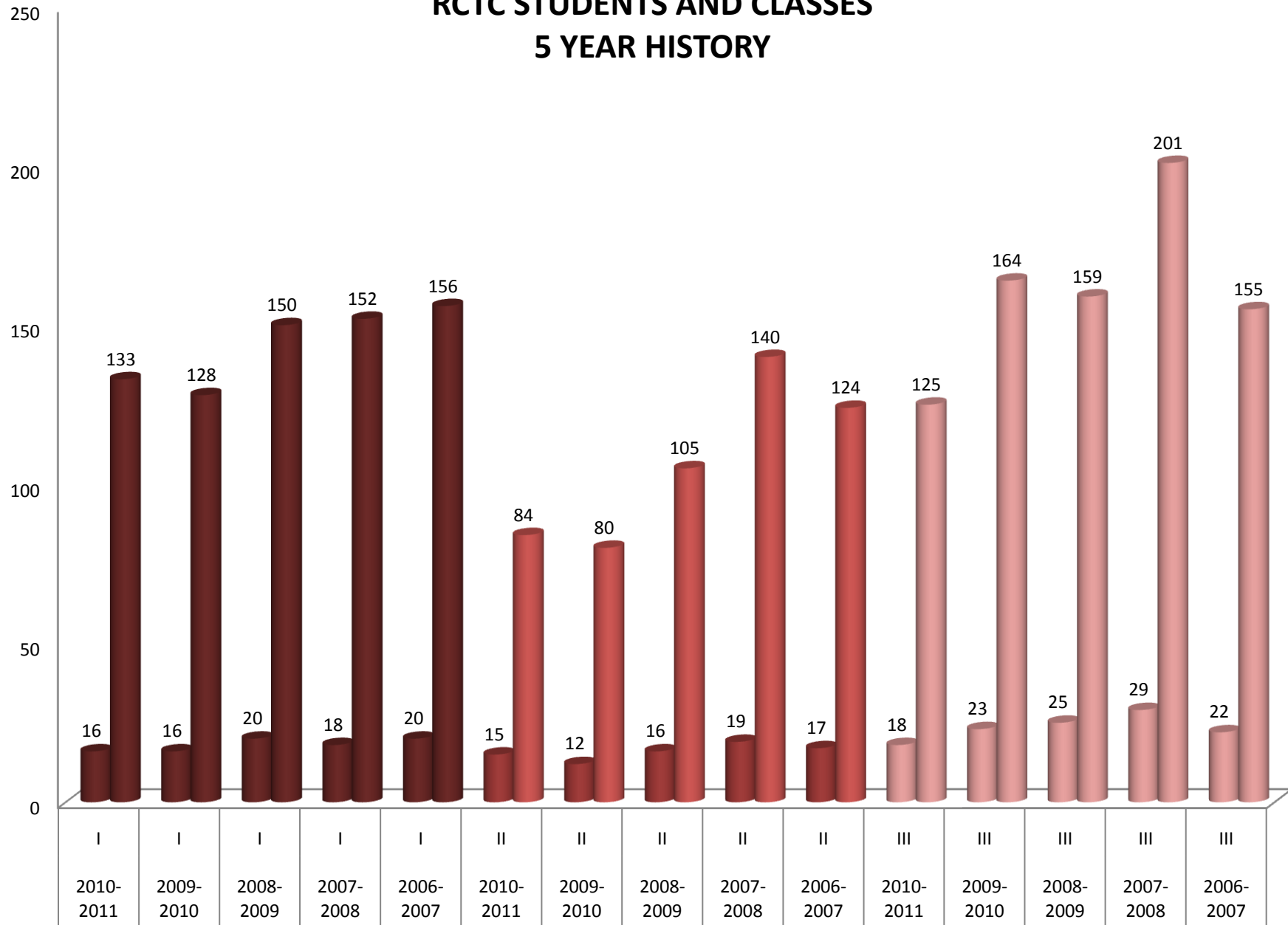
Eleven New Choices participants are currently enrolled in RCTC classes for Term III. At the end of this term, we will work on resumes, job search, and interviewing skills.

We received well over 50 calls about the pre-apprenticeship program for women. Applications were sent and intake interviews conducted to select up to 20 individuals for this “pilot” program. Classes begin February 21 and will consist of a blend of New Choices workshops, Math, Blueprint Reading, and hands-on training in various construction skills. At this time we are also investigating the possibility of adding OSHA 10 certification and a field trip to a construction site.
