Term III begins the week of January 24. We will be running 22 classes with 125 students. This seven-week term will end on March 10.

Unfortunately twelve other classes had to be canceled as they did not meet the minimum enrollment number needed.

New Choices Career Development/WANTO

A new class began on January 10, meeting at ECTS Monday through Thursday evenings through February 23. There are nine participants in this class.

As part of the WANTO grant, Mary Ellen is meeting with ECTS' senior girls enrolled in nontraditional labs. The first meeting was held on December 17 and will continue on a monthly basis. The purpose is to provide support, resources, and information pertaining to employment opportunities in apprenticeship programs and other nontraditional areas.

A pre-apprenticeship training program is scheduled to begin on February 21. This is open to adult women and will be our first class under the WANTO grant. This eleven -week program will teach math, introduce students to carpentry, electrical, and plumbing, and provide instruction on work readiness / soft skills.
