Fourteen students from our HVAC program tested on November 20 for the EPA 608 Certification. We offer this national certification test twice yearly.

Information on career planning, including training opportunities and local labor market needs, was presented to parenting students at East, Central, and Strong Vincent High Schools the week of November 15.

The Department of Labor & Industry has placed a temporary moratorium on issuing vouchers for weatherization training as employer demand has been less than expected. We provided the physical assessment to individuals prior to their being placed in training.

New Choices Career Development

No classes will be held over the holidays as traditionally it is a difficult time to get people to attend. This gives us the opportunity to meet with graduates to provide job search assistance, interview practice, resume updates, and other supportive services.

We are also currently recruiting for New Choices and the Wanto grant; both will begin in January.
