

High School Activity Report

February 2012

Tornado Drill: The school conducted a campus wide TORNADO DRILL on January 27th. The drill was a success because each lab cooperated and conducted themselves in a professional manner.

Union City Board Meeting: On Thursday, February 2nd Joe Tarasovitch attended the monthly Union City Board Meeting to share and discuss Erie County Technical School enrollment and programs. Mr. Tarasovitch was accompanied by Tonya Grossman, a Drafting and Design student who also made a presentation about the DDE lab. Tonya shared a special gift - a “PEZ” candy dispenser with the group that she produced in the lab.

2nd Quarter Recognition: The second quarter grading period concluded on January 19, 2012 and with that conclusion, the Erie County Technical School recognized three groups of outstanding students with certificates for the following accomplishments:

Perfect Attendance: 91 students had PERFECT ATTENDANCE in the 2nd Quarter which represented 12% of the ECTS population.

Honor Roll Students: 126 students achieved the HONOR ROLL status; or 17% of the student body.

Distinguished Student: 45 ECTS students achieved this recognition; which accounts for 6% of the student population.

NAEP testing: The National Assessment of Educational Progress test was administered to a random group of seniors during the week of February 6th. The test is an assessment driven by the “Technical Centers That Work” (TCTW) program in which ECTS has an affiliation.

The 57 seniors that completed the testing process were evaluated in three curriculum areas; Mathematics, Reading and Science. The students also completed a survey that ECTS will utilize the results to improve the school.
