Senior Awards Ceremony:

ECTS 4th Quarter Honors:

Perfect Attendance: 134 students had Perfect Attendance in the 4th Quarter which represented 18% of our population. **27 students had a perfect attendance record for the 2011-12 school year.**

Honor Roll: 90 students obtained the Honor Roll status which represented 12% of the ECTS student body. **32 students accomplished the feat of being on the Honor Roll for the entire 2011-12 school year.**

Distinguished Student: 29 students have been recognized as Distinguished Student in the 4th Quarter; which is 4% of the student body.
