

Supervisors of Instructional Support Services Report
May 2012
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END-OF-PROGRAM TESTING

NOCTI: NOCTI test results are in. Of 191 students tested, 107 scored at the Advanced Level Overall (56%); 42 scored at the Competent Level Overall (22%) with a combined total of 78% scoring Advanced or Competent. We are happy to report that these school-wide results surpass the *2011-2012 Perkins Performance Level goal of 67.5% of testers scoring at the Advanced or Competent Level.*

On the written portion of the test, all our nineteen programs surpassed the Perkins goal. Fourteen of our programs surpassed the goal at the Advanced Level.

Students who scored at the Advanced Level on both the Written and Performance Assessments (107) will receive the Pennsylvania Skills Certificate at the ECTS Awards Assembly on May 30th. Those who scored Competent Overall will receive the PA Certificate of Competency (42). These certificates make an impressive addition to the students' portfolios and resumes.

PrintED: Two students from the Graphic Design program earned the Skills-USA/PrintED certification for Graphic Communications Proficiency. They are Desare Kimbrough and Emily Cracolici both from the General McLane School District.

NIMS: Three Precision Machining students earned the Pennsylvania Skills Certificate for passing a minimum of four NIMS certification tests. Two additional students earned the Pennsylvania Certificate of Competency for passing at least three tests.
