LITERACY : Our numeracy and literacy coaches presented an ECTS best practice at the PDE Northwest Pennsylvania Coaches Clinic. The coaches presented their idea of the PSSA jeopardy tip-off activity to their peers from CTC's across the Northwest region. Our coaches returned with a new way of creating student profiles that they learned from the clinic. This practice has changed how we organize the eighth-grade PSSA reading and math testing results to determine which students will most benefit from reading and math support.

SPECIAL EDUCATION: Jan and Pat are meeting with our district counselors, special education supervisors, case managers and even students and parents, to help finalize the goals and plans for students with disabilities for the 2012-2013 school year. At this time, we have admitted 316 total students for next year. Of these students, 79 are special needs. This makes up 26% of the total number of students enrolled. This year, 33 % of our graduating senior class are students with special needs.
