

Department of Education review of AYP for the Erie County Technical School

According to PDE data from 2011--

In 2009, 44.7% of your students scored at the proficient or advanced level in reading on the PSSA.

In 2011, 57.4% of your students scored at the proficient or advanced level in reading on the PSSA.

This represents an increase of 28.4% which means that you exceeded the PDE required increase of 10.2%.

In 2009, 35.9% of your students scored at the proficient or advanced level in math on the PSSA.

In 2011, 53.7% of your students scored at the proficient or advanced level in math on the PSSA.

This represents an increase of 49.6% which means that you exceeded the PDE required increase of 11.5%.

In 2009, 60.7% of your students scored at the competent or advanced level on the NOCTI.

In 2011, 80.9% of your students scored at the competent or advanced level on the NOCTI.

This represents an increase of 33.3% which means that you exceeded the PDE required increase of 13% and also exceeded the expected 2010-2011 Final Agreed Upon Performance Level (FAUPL) of 64% as required by the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act.

The Erie County Technical School also was awarded a certificate for exceeding an 80% or higher school-wide student achievement at the competent and advanced levels on the NOCTI.
