Guidelines	The Operating Committee recognizes the continuing interests of adult members of the community in educational growth and advancement and the need of both adults and minors for learning programs not available to them in the regular program of the school. The policies and procedures of the Erie County Technical School Operating Committee shall govern the operation of the adult education programs, and all students enrolled in such programs shall adhere to such established policies and procedures. Admission to the adult education program shall be open to all adults irrelevant of their residency. The Operating Committee shall set annually the tuition rate rates/fees for the adult education program. <u>Regional Career & Technical Center</u> Courses offered are to serve and meet the training needs of business and industry. The adult education program is designed to meet the adult and continuing education needs of Northwest Pennsylvania; to emphasize entry-level employee skills, but not to exclude employee upgrade skills. The adult education program shall be operated on a full-time or part-time schedule, as needed.
