

High School Activity Report

August 2013

Preliminary Enrollment:

As of August 8, 2013 the 2013-2014 reports are indicating a study body of 831 students. These are 10 programs that have an enrollment capacity of 90% or better – ADS, AUT, CMP, CNT, COS, ECE, FMT, HEA, MTF and PMT.

Principal Meeting:

The Erie County Principals gathered on Wednesday, August 14th for their first of four scheduled sessions.
