Working with Infinite Campus to establish contract scope.

Upgraded our eClass.ects.org Sharepoint system to Sharepoint 2013 with Office Web Apps, which will enable students to edit Office document with just a web browser. It's like Office 365, or Google Docs, but with a lot more control, extensibility, and flexibility.
