

High School Activity Report February 2014

2nd Quarter Recognition: With the end of the second quarter occurring on January 16th, ECTS recognized outstanding students in these categories:

Perfect Attendance: 161 students had Perfect Attendance in the 2nd quarter which represented 21% of the ECTS population.

Honor Roll Students: 93 students achieved the Honor Roll status; 12% of the student body.

Distinguished Students: 34 ECTS students achieved the Distinguished Student recognition which accounts for 4% of the student population.
