“Ready To” Series ...

The Career Planning Coordinator (CPC) continued to provide workshops from the “Ready To” Series to the students at ECTS during the past month.

From “Ready to Live”, workshops on *School Success* were conducted to the level one students in the following labs: AUR, AUT, ELC, EEC, DDE, CMP and CNT. This workshop will continue to be offered in the classroom until the end of the school year.

Workshops on Problem Solving/Decision Making, from the “*Ready to Work*” series have been conducted with both the AM and PM students from all labs.

The final *SAT/ ACT registration* workshop took place on May 8 from “Ready for College.” This workshop was intended for any student interested in SAT/ACT testing before the end of this school year. *College Exploration and Scholarships Search* workshops will continue to take place in May for those students interested in exploring their post-secondary options. The most recent workshops took place on May 15th and May 20th. The CPC also continues to provide information about available scholarships to students as it becomes available.

Each month, the Career Planning Coordinator accepts nominations for the Millcreek Kiwanis Citizenship Award.
