Alternative Education Program and PDE Approvals

District Applications – Districts wishing to participate in the CAEP Alternative Education Program must now submit their own application with an application fee of \$400 per program. Dr. Jackson and Frank DiPlacido will work with districts to provide the necessary information for the applications.

Career Street Update

Compensation for Liaison – It was decided that liaisons would not receive a separate fee for performing these duties.

8th Grade Career Readiness Survey – Superintendents were asked to have the 8th grade survey completed prior to the end of the year. A request was made for a summary of the previous surveys to be shared with the area schools.

ECVTS Foundation EITC Letter of Support – Superintendents were reminded to submit their letters of support for the Foundation's EITC project.

Important Statistics and Accomplishments - The following highlights from the first full year of Career Street were shared; 162 registered participants, 300 local students have had a Career Street exploration experience, 2 Community Tours included in Superintendents and Guidance Counselors, 92 Public Speaking Engagements, various media coverage

ECTS Renovation – Act 29 Project

Dr. Jackson shared the JOC's request to investigate incorporating an Act 29 project into the renovation. Superintendent's shared information pertaining to the various vendors they used for further investigation. Options shared were Seimans, Smart Edge and Tour Andover (TAC). Several districts have had great success with these projects and several districts have not pursued them because the "low hanging fruit" projects have already been completed.

School Nurse for ECTS

ECTS is in need of a nurse for portions of the day to distribute medications. Discussions were held on options to meet this need such as distributing meds prior to coming to ECTS or upon returning to home district if at all possible. It was also suggested to reach out to local hospitals, Urgent Cares, and doctor's offices to see if they could provide a contracted nurse for few hours per day.
